****Only vehicles being used in the parade will be allowed on the church grounds. Private vehicles need to be parked in lots or on side streets near the church. Please be certain to inform ALL the participants in your group of the parking rules. See Parade Guidelines & Rules. If you are physically disabled, please let us know any special accommodations you need.*

Parade Guidelines & Rules

The Kena Shriners will be setting up in the Masonic Lodge parking lot. That lot will, therefore, be closed to the public. Please park in the lots around the parade route, and walk, or car pool to the drop off location at the church parking lot.

- 1. No candy is to be thrown from vehicles. It may be handed out to the crowds by participants walking along either side of the street.**
2. Groups including elected officials and candidates, and especially those with youth participation are encouraged to meet at a pre-determined location and come together to the church.
- 3. No cars or trucks other than those in the parade will be allowed to turn into the church parking lot. Please notify EVERYONE in your group of this rule as they will be turned away from the Church. Please park on side streets near the church.**
4. Politicians are to limit their entourage to one vehicle and no more than 12 supporters walking with them. Only one politician or candidate per entry. Additional supporters can join the parade at the end with their respective political parties. Please make note on your application if you will have additional supporters marching at the end of the parade.
5. Participants are to be driven to and dropped off at the parade starting point at the Annandale United Methodist Church, 6935 Columbia Pike, Annandale no later than 9:00 AM and picked up at the end of the parade at 4245 Markham St...Bowling Alley/Safeway Shopping Center on Little River Turnpike by Noon. Please be on time!
6. Each participating unit should be identified by a banner or sign on the vehicle or preceding their unit.
7. Any group with a special routine may pause in front of the reviewing stand. **Please limit your performance to one minute.**
8. Those in a vehicle must stay in the vehicle during the parade. Officials may be taken to the reviewing stands after completing the parade route.
9. If you are a musical group, please test your equipment in advance of arriving at the staging area.
- 10. This parade will take place RAIN OR SHINE and will be followed by our Fall Festival in the parking lot of Safeway at Markham St. and Little River Turnpike. (10am-5pm)**
11. The Annandale Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to limit the size of any group due to the restricted size of our staging area.
